

## Arts and Humanities Research Council

The AHRC has awarded the University a limited number of Block Grant Partnership Studentships for MA and Research students accepted to begin courses in 2009-10 academic year. The specific subject areas are Communications, Graphics and Photography; Conservation; Design; Film, Digital and Media Production and Fine Art.

Only students who applied to the course before the published deadline of 9<sup>th</sup> February 2009, who meet the eligibility and residence requirements and have accepted their offer of a place can be considered for these Studentships. The level of competition this year for limited funding is high. Candidates will be notified of the decision from the University's Scrutiny panel by the beginning of May.

Please be advised that the AHRC reserves the right not to approve a nomination for a studentship if the candidate does not meet the appropriate eligibility criteria, aims of the scheme, the BGP studentship they have been nominated for or, if the recruitment process appears to be unfair. The AHRC will notify successful candidates in July.
